

Golf Operational Guidelines

Things You Need to Know

BOOKING AND PAYMENT

- Tee times recommended, walk on's allowed.
- **Tee times available:**
 - **April to May 20th – 9am to 6pm; May 21st to Sept 6 – 7am to 7pm; after Sept 7 – 9am to 6pm**
 - Members can book two weeks in advance. Members are encouraged to book early!
- Tee times will be a minimum of **10 minutes** apart.
- General Public can book online through our website *one week* in advance. You can call the proshop to book a tee time but please be advised we have limited staff so not all calls will be answered immediately, so online booking is your best option.
- Power cart rental is charged per rider. Previous restrictions of only one rider per cart has been lifted so players can now ride with others. However, it still suggested that sharing of power carts should be limited to those persons in the same or extended households. Please let our proshop staff know if you are comfortable sharing with others.
- Due to the restricted number of tee times, we will encourage twosomes to join another twosome.
- Punch cards are permitted.
- Payment preference is with card (credit, debit). We will accept cash but want everyone to be mindful that we are trying to reduce the handling of cash for the safety of our staff, therefore we may not have correct change for your cash.

ARRIVAL AT THE COURSE

- Upon arrival at our course... you will be asked to check-in at the proshop where you will be provided further instructions from our staff... at a safe distance of course. We ask that you arrive at the window no earlier than 10 minutes before your tee time. If you are renting power carts, those will be issued when you are permitted to tee off.
- There will be no scorecards, pencils available on course. We will issue you a score card and pencil at the designated sign in area
- The clubhouse restaurant area is OPEN for use. Washrooms available and only 1 person will be allowed in to utilize the washroom at a time. Washrooms on the course are available for use and will be cleaned/sanitized regularly.
- **The Proshop area is open for clothing, golf ball and accessories purchases. Customers should minimize touching merchandise. NO RETURNS OF MECHANIDISE WILL BE ACCEPTED but we will allow trying on of clothing. Any clothing tried on but not purchased will be isolated for 24 hours prior to returning for sale.**
- Putting Green and Driving Net are open for use of patrons but MUST maintain physical distancing at all times.
- We will have cold beverages and some grab snacks available at the concession slide-up window. Payment must be credit or debit ('TAP'), NO CASH. The machine will be sanitized after each use.

RULES & RESTRICTIONS FOR YOUR GOLF ROUND

Based on the Provincial's mandate that allows golf to be played please keep in mind:

- **Physical distancing must always be observed, with a minimum of two metres between individuals**
- Players who exhibit signs of illness will not be permitted to play
- Flags will remain in the hole and the cup will have a **pool noodle inside** so the ball does not drop in the hole. Play is concluded when the ball contacts the cup. **DO NOT TOUCH THE FLAG STICK**
- All rakes and ball washers are removed from the course.
- There will be no club rentals. Only power cart or pull carts for rental.
- Washroom facilities are open on the course. They will be cleaned and sanitized regularly.

AFTER YOUR GOLF ROUND

- Return any power cart/pull cart rental to designated areas
- Please vacate the parking lot/premises as soon as you have complete your round unless you are going to patronize the restaurant.
- The restaurant and patio are open to the public at reduced capacity. If you are coming in after your round to enjoy some food and beverages, we ask that you review the restaurant guidelines.
